

MUCKAMORE ABBEY HOSPITAL INQUIRY

**RESTRICTION ORDER
PURSUANT TO SECTION 19 OF THE INQUIRIES ACT 2005**

**Restriction Order No. 93
("Redaction of the statement of Jill Duffie")**

I have power under section 19(1)(b) of the Inquiries Act 2005 to make orders restricting disclosure or publication of evidence or documents given, produced or provided to the Inquiry.

This order relates to redaction of the statement of Jill Duffie (MAHI – STM – 337) dated 25 October 2024.

I am satisfied that, in addition to any redaction applied under the authority of existing restriction orders, further redaction of the statement, in the way specified below, is necessary in order to ensure other restriction orders are observed and for the effective working of the Inquiry. I am satisfied that the Order is conducive to the Inquiry fulfilling its Terms of Reference and is necessary in the public interest having regard to the matters specified in section 19(4).

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. In paragraph 6 of the statement of Jill Duffie (MAHI – STM – 337), text in the first sentence shall be redacted.
2. In paragraph 6 of the statement of Jill Duffie (MAHI – STM – 337), the second sentence shall be redacted.
3. In paragraph 8 of the statement of Jill Duffie (MAHI – STM – 337), the fourth sentence shall be redacted.
4. In paragraph 17 of the statement of Jill Duffie (MAHI – STM – 337), the final sentence shall be redacted.
5. This Order remains in force for the duration of the Inquiry and at all times thereafter, unless otherwise ordered.
6. I may vary or revoke this Order by making a further Order during the course of the Inquiry.

Any threat to break this Order, or any breach of it, can be certified to the High Court under section 36 of the Inquiries Act, which will deal with it as though the breach had occurred

in proceedings before that Court.
